Since the start of October seven people have died at work, including a 48-year-old man who was hit by a forklift last week while delivering turf to a home near Lake Eildon. His death brought to 25 the number of people who have died so far this year - an increase of seven compared with the same time last year. WorkSafe Victoria spokesman Michael Birt said the lead-up to Christmas, and the return from holidays, were often the most dangerous times of year for injuries and fatalities.
