31-Oct-09	Unknown		M		Electrocuted	Nov 18 AAP Bridbane - Master Electricians chief executive Malcolm Richards told the Nine Network he was horrified to hear a second installer had died. In October, Mr Richards called for an immediate end to the program, prompted by the death of an insulation installer. The man was electrocuted after a staple, used to fix foil insulation in the roof space of a home, pierced a cable that electrified the foil. A second man also received an electric shock and burns in that accident.	Construction	1
18-Nov-09	Unknown		M	16	Electrocuted	BRISBANE, Nov 18 AAP - A 16-year-old boy has died in a workplace accident from an apparent electric shock. He is the second Queensland insulation installer contractor to die in recent weeks. The teenager was on the roof of a house in Cocks Road, Stanwell, southwest of Rockhampton, when the accident happened about 9.20am (AEST). A second person who received a minor shock was taken to Rockhampton Base Hospital in a stable condition.	Construction	1
